PURPOSE AND SCOPE

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY AND MANAGEMENT

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

While awaiting UNI EN ISO 14001 environmental certification, Tecnova formalizes its commitment to manage and reduce the impact of its activities on the surrounding environment, in compliance with applicable environmental laws and the following principles:

- Responsibility towards the environment must be considered on the same level as other management aspects of the company and customer requirements;
- The environmental impact of each activity carried out must be assessed, monitored, and reduced, including in order to prevent and/or manage emergency situations;
- The use of energy resources must be gradually optimized in order to minimize it;
- Waste generated must be reduced, recycled, or reused as much as possible;
- The design of new processes must take into account all possible environmental implications; processes must be constantly reviewed to minimize their environmental effects, always favoring the best available and economically feasible technologies;
- When selecting suppliers, preference shall be given to the use of clean technologies and the adoption of environmental management systems;
- Tecnova aims to raise employee awareness towards increasing attention to environmental protection, while also promoting collaboration with public authorities and local communities;
